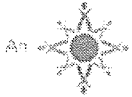

Homeless Crisis Response Program

HCRP Services

The Homeless Crisis Response Program is intended to serve individuals and/or families in Carroll County who are currently homeless (as defined by HUD) or at imminent risk of becoming homeless with no other appropriate housing options and lack both the financial assistance and support networks needed to obtain or maintain immediate housing.

Every household assisted by the program is provided case management to help them identify needs, establish a safe living situation, and to create a plan that connects them to the resources needed to help them obtain and maintain housing.

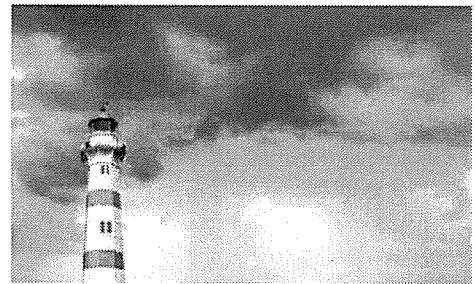
Each household's case plan may include:

- Case Management
- Referrals to housing opportunities.
- Referrals to community services.
- Referrals to employment and or educational opportunities
- Budgeting assistance.

Eligible Referrals

The household is homeless or at imminent risk of homelessness and looking to maintain permanent housing.

Very Low Income – Less than 30% of area median income (based on family size). Call for income criteria.



Diversion and Referral services are available for all individuals and families experiencing homelessness in Carroll County.
